

Warsaw, WWTP Czajka Poland



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On 30 January 2008 the contract was signed for the expansion of the "Czajka" Sewage Plant - sewage section and the preparation of sludge for disposal.

Technical details

WTE was responsible for the design and mechanical equipment of the preliminary and primary treatment of waste water treatment plant with a maximum capacity of 510,000 m³/d (2,1 million PE) as well as sludge treatment.

The main driver on the extensive modernization project was the need to meet EU wastewater standards – including limits on nitrogen of 10 mg/l and 1 mg/l for phosphorus, effective from January 2007 – and to provide adequate treatment for all urban effluent flows.



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
